

Tarinoil

Glazing paint based on pine tar

General

Tarinoil is a thin liquid with pine tar scent, a simple mixture of the natural products pine tar, linseed oil and gum turpentine. Similar compounds have been traditional for decades and offer wooden surfaces a long time protection. The content of effective ingredients is very high, even the gum turpentine can be counted among them, being a pine tree derivate.

Range of application

Tarinoil has good penetration qualities on soft, and porous wooden surfaces. Due to a relatively long drying time, it is recommended to avoid using it on hard wood or wood that previously has been treated and which surfaces are unpenetrable.

Instructions for use

Make sure that the wood is absolutely dry before you tar it. NB! Do not apply on skin.
